### **TECHNICAL DATA**

Binder: Synthetic binder.

Solid content: 27-48 % w/w depending on colour.

Density: 1.02-1.23 g/ml depending on colour.

Viscosity: Approx. 20 s in DIN cup 4 mm at 20 °C.

Theoretical consumption: 7-10 m²/l on sawn timber.

#### **APPLICATION DETAILS**

System treatment:

Pre-treatment: The wood must be clean and free from wood dust and contamination. The moisture content of

the wood should not exceed 18 %.

All softwood and non-durable hardwood for exterior use should either be vacuum impregnated

(only softwood) or treated with a wood preservative.

Application: To be applied in brush coater or with brush.

Application conditions: The product is delivered ready for use. Stir the product well before use.

Film thickness: 100-150 µm wet

To obtain the best possible hiding power it might be necessary with 2 treatments. The first

Drying times: Determined at 20 °C and 50 % relative humidity:

Dry to handle: 2-3 hours
Dry to recoat: 24 hours

The drying time can be reduced using special drying systems to force drying. The drying times are approximate and may vary according to wood quality, temperatures, humidity, ventilation and

film thickness.

Sawn timber can be piled rough side to planed side (wet on wet). White and grey colours should

be piled with joist.

Cleaning: The equipment is cleaned with water.
