During spray-application provide adequate ventilation. Comply with the health and safety at work laws.

If ventilation during spray-application is not sufficient, use respiratory protection with gas, vapour and dust filter AP.
- 8.2.1.2 **Hand protection**
Always wear protective gloves (e.g. nitrile rubber). Barrier creams may also help to protect the exposed areas of the skin.
- 8.2.1.3 **Eye protection**
During spray-application use safety eyewear designed to protect against splashes of liquids.
